Cervical Cancer Awareness and Screening Camps



Arpana Hospital organized four village screening camps in May.

4 days of home visits were conducted by 1 rural staff, 14 mobilizers and 5 Self-Help Group trainers to raise awareness about this important service.

About 300 women were tested and those affected were referred to Arpana Hospital for treatment.

Arpana's Free Medical Camps in Remote Himachal Villages

Arpana's Health Centre in Bakrota, Dalhousie, is providing daily outpatient clinics to hill folk. Free village and specialist medical camps are largely supported by the Baij Nath Bhandari Public Charitable Trust.

Dr. Magotra, MBBS, Master in Clinical Tropical Medicine, and Arpana's Senior Medical Officer, held the latest Arpana Camps:

- April 6, in village Balera: 127 patients, 100 blood tests, 82 had high blood sugar.
- May 11, in village Khalander/Guniyala:
 140 patients, 116 blood tests, 77 had
 high blood sugar, 28 ECG tests, and 71
 injections for joint/ abdominal pain,
 osteoarthritis, allergies, etc.
