Arpana's Free Medical Camps in Remote Himachal Villages

Continuing Arpana's mission to deliver healthcare services to remote, isolated villages, Arpana organized medical camps in June, July and August, treating 451 patients with the support of the Baij Nath Bhandari Public Charitable Trust in:

- Deol Village: 68 patients on June 8
- · Village Kugti: 153 patients on July 7
- Rakhed Village, Chamba: for 160 patients on August 10
- Mobile Camps for 70 Nomads were organized on 11th August, 2025, at Kalaban Dudher, Dainkund Gujjar Dera and Pohlani Mata Mandir.
